Reading Strategies for Unpacking Texts with Beginner EAL/D Learners

With our beginner and post-beginner students, there is so much to consider when it comes to teaching reading. We have to consider factors such as pre-literacy, accessible texts and vocabulary, simple, clear formatting, careful sequencing of activities, repetition and recycling, cognitive load, building learner confidence and so much more. In this session, we will use the '*Before, During and After Reading*' technique as a framework for unpacking texts with our beginner level students. In this practical session, we will explore a range of activities and strategies to use within each phase of the framework, which have been successfully trialled in the classroom.
